DeBarnardo reported that to date this organization has given over \$60,000 to CCF and their donations are making possible the payout of scholarship to students studying either banking or accounting with a goal of obtaining CPA certification.

L. Burroughs reported that due to a need for increased bond measure support, at their April 21, 2016 meeting the Executive Committee approved an additional up to \$110,000 in funding.

### **Investment Report**

M. Machado presented the March 31, 2016 Investment Activity Report.

The return on investments for fiscal year to date as of March 31, 2016 (nine months) is -3.25%.

### **Financial Statements**

M. Machado presented the March 31, 2016 condensed financial report. As of March 31, 2016 the total assets were \$29M and ending net assets were \$27,746,000. The total revenue for all funds was \$3,209,000. Total expenses were \$1,830,000 with a net surplus for all funds of \$1,379,000. The total operating revenue was \$825,000 and expenses \$756,000. The operating surplus was \$69,000.

Total Net Assets, Endowed Net Assets, and Historical Gifts Charts as of March 31, 2016

The total net assets balance as of March 31, 2016 was \$27,745,861; this is the highest net assets balance in Cabrillo College Foundation history. The endowed net assets balance was \$22,163,826. The endowed historical gifts value was \$18,718,661.

#### July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017 Foundation Operational Budget
