

# Cabrillo College at a Glance

## ENROLLMENT FEES

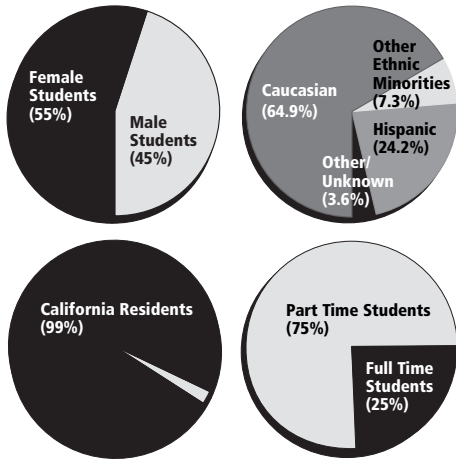
As of fall semester 2005, enrollment fees are \$26 per unit for California residents. Out-of-state students pay a total of \$190 per unit. International students pay a total of \$192 per unit. In addition, all students pay health services and transportation fees.

## STUDENT ENROLLMENT

Fall semester 2004 enrollment was almost 15,000.

## STUDENT PROFILE

In spring 2004, 55% of the students were female and 45% were male. A total of 31.5% of the students were ethnic minorities and 24.2% of the enrollees were Hispanic. About 75% of the students were enrolled on a part-time basis. The average age of students was 30.2. Santa Cruz County residents comprised 90% of the student population, with 10% from elsewhere in California, and a small fraction from out of state.



## STUDENT SUCCESS

Cabrillo College ranks among the top ten California community colleges in the number of students transferring to the University of California. At CSU, Cabrillo College students earn higher grade point averages than students who began their college study at CSU. Occupational students also are very successful. A recent state-wide study shows that graduates of Cabrillo occupational programs earn significantly more money and have a higher rate of employment than those without degrees or certificates.

## ANNUAL BUDGET

The 2003-2004 Cabrillo College budgeted general fund income was approximately \$55 million.

## ECONOMIC IMPACT

Payroll, student financial aid, plus purchase of goods and services multiplies to an estimated \$100 million annual impact on the local community.

## NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES

As of June 2005, Cabrillo College employed 215 contract faculty, 389 adjunct faculty, 238 classified staff, 13 confidential employees and 34 managers and administrators.

## APTOS FACILITIES

Cabrillo College is situated on 162 acres in Aptos on hills overlooking Monterey Bay. Campus facilities include a student center, theater, library/learning resources center, gymnasium, childcare center, stadium, swimming pool, computer technology center, various classrooms and laboratories, and the historic Sesnon House.

## OTHER SITES

Open since 1987, the Cabrillo College Watsonville Center expanded in fall 2001. The new addition features state-of-the-art classrooms and laboratories for up to 5000 students. Cabrillo College also offers classes and student services in downtown Santa Cruz. Students may participate in distance education through telecourses and online courses.
